

Effective November 13, 2009

Osceola County has begun receiving its allocation of 2009 H1N1 Influenza Vaccine. These vaccines are being disbursed to obstetricians, pediatricians, walk-in clinics and other physicians who serve the priority groups and are registered in Florida Shots.

The priority groups are:

- Pregnant women
- People who live with or care for infants younger than 6 months of age
- Health care and emergency medical personnel
- Anyone from 6 months through 24 years of age
- Anyone from 25 through 64 years of age with certain chronic medical conditions or a weakened immune system

If you are in this priority group, please contact your provider to see if the H1N1 vaccine is available at their office.
